Criteria for Eligibility

- Applicant exhibits excellence in leadership, extracurricular activities, community service, academics and potential for future success.
- Must be a graduating female senior from Hay Springs High School and 20 years of age or under by application deadline.
- Applicant plans to attend an accredited post-secondary educational institution (2-year, 4-year, technical or vocational school) full-time in the fall of the academic year following her high school graduation.

Scholarship Uses

The non-renewable P.E.O. Chapter FO Scholarship may be used for non-taxable uses such as tuition, fees and books. Alternatively, funds may also be used for items that may be taxable such as room and board. The recipient and her family will make the decision on use of funds and will be responsible for any tax implications.

How to Apply

- Complete a Student Profile, Student Activity Chart and letter of application.
- Letter of Application must include the college you plan to attend, your intended Major and must be neatly typed.
- Submit materials to the P.E.O. chapter contact person postmarked by **Monday April 3rd, 2017**.
- Complete a personal interview with the P.E.O. Scholarship Committee. The committee will contact you at a later date to schedule the interview.
