Look at what we are up to...

The preschool class has been learning about Thanksgiving and the letter E. Throughout the week we discussed what it means to be thankful. We created a thankful turkey that can be found in our hallway. Everyone came up with some good things they were thankful for. During the week we talked about turkeys. On Monday, we created turkeys by drawing on coffee filters and then painting them with water so that the colors would bleed together. We added a turkey body and added them to our individual 'How to Cook a Turkey' recipe We had a lot of fun reading each others recipes!

The afternoon class explored their spatial concepts of on, beside, in and under by creating a "Where is the Turkey" book. They also completed their letter E book. The students are really getting into letter sounds. Some have even started sounding out simple words. Reading these books with your child daily is great practice for them.

The morning class is reviewing good manners, being respectful and following directions along with exploring Thanksgiving. Thanksgiving is a great time to review these concepts while eating and being around family.
