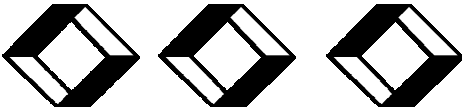
Welcome

Day Camp Descriptions

ANIMAL PLANET

AM-4DAYS

Week 4

\$20

Grades K-1. This camp will focus on: farm animals, zoo animals, and sea animals. Campers will have the opportunity to watch baby chicks hatch, as well as take a virtual tour or two. Campers need to be sure to wear comfortable walking shoes, sunscreen, jacket, and bring a water bottle.

Grades 3-8. This camp will focus on basketball fundamentals: shooting, dribbling, passing, and some defense as well as rules and terms of the game. Campers should wear gym clothes and bring clean tennis shoes to wear on the Lister-Sage gym floor.

BEGINNING HAND CHIMES

PRE-K FUN CAMP

Grades PK. This camp is designed for pre-school children ages 3 and up who are toilet-trained and have not yet attended Kindergarten. Come join us on our Preschool Fun Camp! We will explore and do fun activities to promote social skills and early learning skills.

ROCKETS

Grades 3-5. Model rockets-including ones we will be building-can reach thousands of feet and beyond. At this summer camp, you will learn how to build small model rockets from common household items and then progress up to building a high-performance rocket that can hit 500 mph and fly a half mile into the sky. Experience the thrill of seeing a rocket glider roar up and come safely back down!

RUBE GOLDBERG MACHINES

AM-4DAYS Week 3 \$20

Grades 4-8. This camp will explore the science & theory behind Rube Goldberg machines. Rube Goldberg machines take a ridiculously complicated route from point A to B and students will get hands on experience exploring this.

RUN, FUN, & FITNESS CAMP

AM-4DAYS Week 3 \$20

Grades PK-6. This camp will be split into two level and is designed for preschool through 6th grades. The two camp sponsors will explore the basics of running and fitness as well as fun ways to stay fit & healthy.

SIMPLE CRAFTS

AM-4DAYS Week 3 \$20

Grades 3-5. This camp will focus on easy-to-do crafts. Campers will create fun and useful household crafts. All necessary supplies will be provided.

THE THREE R'S

AM-4DAYS Week 4 \$20

Grades PK. This preschool camp theme will focus on “the three R’s” - reduce, reuse, recycle! We will explore and do fun activities to learn about the three R’s and to promote social and early learning skills.

THEATRE

AM-4DAYS Week 4 \$20

Grades 3-8. This camp will focus on the basics of theatre. Students will learn basic stage directions, the fundamentals of acting, and will put on a small play production.

VOLLEYBALL

AM-4DAYS Week 1 \$20

Grades 3-8. This camp is designed to teach and review the fundamentals of volleyball: passing, serving, setting, bumping, and game play.

The helpful hints are written to be a general rule for all camps and campers. When necessary more detailed information has been included in the camp description.

Who Can Attend?

The camps are open to all children from ANY school, ANY town.

Cost

The cost of each camp is listed in the description as well as the summer camp over-

view. Generally the prices are set at \$20 a camper/ per camp.

Registration

Registration will remain open throughout the camps. As some camps may fill quickly, we encourage you to register as early as possible. Camp enrollment is first come, first serve upon full payment.

Payment

Cash will be accepted however, we prefer checks or money orders. Please make payable to: HSPS Summer Camps. You may combine payments for multiple registrations.

Camp Confirmation

You will receive a notification if the camp you requested is full or canceled.

Supervision/Behavior

Summer camp safety is our top priority. School administration will be on campus. Adult supervision as well as pre-screened camp volunteers will be present during each camp session. Students are expected to behave in a safe and respectful manner. If behavior becomes an issue, the parent or designated emergency contact will be expected to remove the child. Inappropriate behavior may result in suspension from further camp activities/sessions.

What to Wear

Wear clothing and shoes that are comfortable and appropriate for both inside and outside activity. A light jacket is encouraged. Campers should not wear flip-flops.

Snack

Small snacks will be provided.

Breakfast

Breakfast will be available from 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. Children 18 and under are free—Adults are welcome to eat for \$1.40. Menus will be posted at www.hshawks.com

Lunch

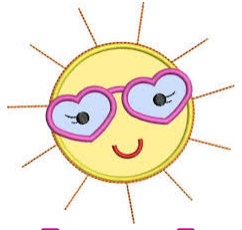

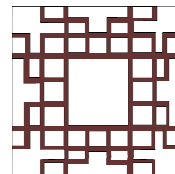
