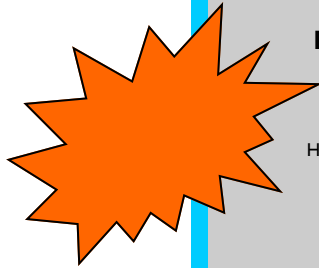

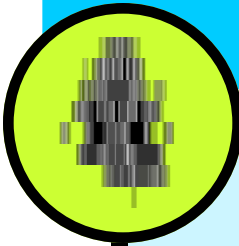

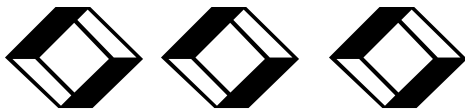
Welcome

Day Camp Descriptions

CAKE DECORATING

AM-4DAYS Week 3 \$20

Grades PK-1. Learn the basics of decorating cakes/cupcakes and cookies. We will make buttercream frosting and learn how to use a piping bag to cover and decorate. Must have previously attended preschool.

COOKING

AM-4DAYS Week 3 \$30

Grades 5-8. Students will learn basic cooking and baking skills as well as learn about healthy eating habits. We will be preparing our breakfast, snack, and lunch everyday. We will also take a trip to the grocery store to learn about buying fresh foods and to shop around for the best price. Wear comfortable clothing and closed toe shoes. Expect to get a little messy.

CREATIVE KIDDOS

AM-4DAYS Week 2 \$20

AM & PM-2DAYS **Week 4** **\$10**

Grades 5-12. Youth will create a business plan, learn how their strengths play into their business, and work with a banker to apply for a loan.

EXPLORING SCIENCE

AM-4DAYS **Week 3** **\$20**

Grades 3-8. The magic of science will be explored through demonstrations and hands-on experiments. We will be exploring different areas of science. This summer, campers will focus on WEATHER. All necessary supplies and equipment will be provided. Campers should wear play clothes—we may get messy.

GETTING CONNECTED

PM-4days **Week 3** **\$20**

Grades 4-6. Learn how circuits are formed and how they work through the use of websites, videos, and hands-on activities. We will create circuits using online activities, circuit components, conducting and insulating play dough, SnapIt circuit kits, copper tape, LED lights, and batteries. All necessary supplies will be provided.

GUITAR

PM-12days **Weeks 1, 3, 4** **\$15**

Grades 3-Adult. We are offering a beginner and intermediate class of guitar during the af-

ternoons, 3-weeks of summer camp (June 6—June 9 & June 20—June 30) for all interested guitar people, big or small, old or young. The classes will be an hour long per class. **1:30 pm to 2:30 pm for beginners; 2:30 pm to 3:30 pm for intermediate players** All you need to bring is a guitar!

HAND CHIMES

PM-12 Days **Weeks 1, 3, 4** **\$15**

We are offering a beginner/intermediate class of hand chimes during the afternoons, during 3-weeks of summer camp (June 6—June 9 & June 20—June 30) for all interested people, big or small, old or young. The participants will learn to use and play hand-chimes, read notes, and play with a group. A knowledge of note reading is not required. The class will run from 12:30 to 1:30.

LEGO COMMUNITY

AM-4DAYS **Week 3** **\$20**

Grades 1-3. Campers will spend the week building with Legos. All supplies and equipment will be provided.

MY MODEL CAR

AM-4DAYS **Week 1** **\$20**

Grades 4-8. My model car camp will introduce participants to the basics of plastic model kit completion. Campers will have a choice of a couple different 70's models cars to build. Campers will be using paint and model glue so plan clothing accordingly. All necessary supplies will be provided.

OUTDOOR SKILLS

AM & PM-1DAY **Week 4** **\$5**

Grades PK-2 This camp will help youth utilize their senses to explore the outdoors. Youth will use their sense of touch, taste, sight, smell, and hearing to learn about the wildlife that surrounds them. Activities include making a bird feeder, painting with spices, making frog calls, and finding different textured items. Please wear outdoor shoes.

REAL-WORLD STEM CHALLENGE

AM-4DAYS **Week 4** **\$20**

Grades 1-3. Children will learn to think like scientists and engineers, as they design, build, and test solutions to real-world problems. Children will also get STEM concepts while building a chain reaction machine. (Rube Goldberg project)

SEWING FUN

AM-4DAYS **Week 2** **\$20**

Grades 3-8. We will explore the basics of sewing. Students will learn to read a pattern, measure & cut fabric, match points, use a sewing machine and all sorts of other fun things. They will complete several projects including a pin cushion, throw pillow and pillow case during the class. All supplies will be provided.

SPORTS & FITNESS

AM-4DAYS **Week 1** **\$20**

Grades 1-8. Campers will explore a variety of sports and fitness activities including but not

limited to: volleyball, football, basketball, wrestling, baseball & softball. We will also complete several different workouts to stay healthy, along with discussions on healthy eating and positive self-image. Wear comfortable clothes and bring both indoor and outdoor shoes.

STOP MOTION ANIMATION

AM-4DAYS **Week 2** **\$20**

Grades 3-5+. At this camp, you will work together as a team to make a stop motion animation film using a camera that we will build in class. After coding a small program on our “camera”, we will use a remote push button to capture pictures of our movie set and then the pictures will be automatically generated into a video using another programming tool. Finally, after a bit of touch-up in a video editing package, we will show our movie on the last day of camp for other campers to watch!

SURF SHACK

AM-4DAYS **Week 0** **FREE**

Grades PK-6. United Methodist Church of Hay Springs is offering Bible School Tuesday, May 31st through Friday, June 3rd from 8:00 to 11:30 am. The theme for the week will be: Surf Shack: Catch the Wave of God's Amazing Love. Children are welcome to enjoy breakfast from 8:00 to 8:30. Lunch and a snack will be provided daily.

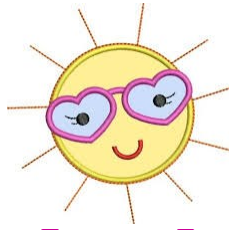

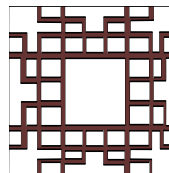

Helpful Hints

The helpful hints are written to be a general rule for all camps and campers. When necessary more detailed information has been included in the camp description.

Who Can Attend?

The camps are open to all children from ANY school, ANY town.

Cost

The cost of each camp is listed in the description as well as the summer camp overview. Generally the prices are set at \$20 a camper/ per camp.

Registration

Registration will remain open throughout the camps. As some camps may fill quickly, we encourage you to register as early as possible. Camp enrollment is first come, first serve upon full payment.

Payment

Cash will be accepted however, we prefer checks or money orders. Please make payable to: HSPS Summer Camps. You may combine payments for multiple registrations.

Camp Confirmation

You will receive a notification if the camp you requested is full or canceled.

Supervision/Behavior

Summer camp safety is our top priority. School administration will be on campus. Adult supervision as well as pre-screened camp volunteers will be present during each camp session. Students are expected to behave in a safe and respectful manner. If behavior becomes an issue, the parent or designated emergency contact will be expected to remove the child. Inappropriate behavior may result in suspension from further camp activities/sessions.

What to Wear

Wear clothing and shoes that are comfortable and appropriate for both inside and outside activity. A light jacket is encouraged. Campers should not wear flip-flops.

Snack

Small snacks will be provided.

Breakfast

Breakfast will be available from 8:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. Children 18 and under are free—Adults are welcome to eat for \$1.45. Menus will be posted at www.hshawks.com

Lunch

Lunch will be available from 11:30 to 12:30 pm. Children 18 and under are free—Adults are welcome to eat for \$3.45. Menus will be posted at www.hshawks.com
