- For over 45 years, the Nebraska Safety Council has been dedicated to traffic safety.



Behind-The-Wheel Instruction (BTW)

Five hours of authentic driving instruction and the 30-minute drive test is included in the curriculum. All students must possess a school or learner's permit before BTW instruction begins.

Drive Lab Schedules

Behind The Wheel schedules in Lincoln summer classes will be established prior to the first classroom meeting. We make every effort to schedule BTW training during the course date(s) your student is scheduled; however, we cannot guarantee it. It may be necessary to schedule drive time prior to or following the course date(s).

Earning the Waiver Form

In order to receive the Provisional Operator's Permit (POP) waiver form, students must complete all coursework and pay all tuition costs. Should a student fail the BTW test, one additional opportunity will be offered at no charge. A subsequent test is available for a \$30 fee.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellations received five (5) business days prior to the first classroom date will receive a full refund. A \$25 charge will be assessed on late cancellations.

Driving Appointment Cancellation Policy

Students must give their instructors at least four (4) hours notice before cancelling a driving appointment. Failure to do this will result in a \$20.00 no call, no show charge and must be paid before students can receive their P.O.P. forms.

Lost P.O.P. Form:

There is a \$5.00 fee to obtain a replacement form if a P.O.P. form is lost or misplaced.



Advance registration and payment are required.



Students must possess a learner's permit to enroll.
