form our letters!

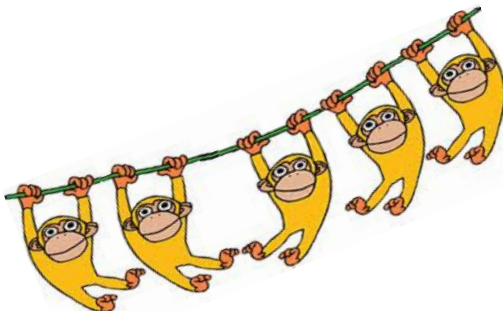
