We ended the week by playing two new games that Ms. Wiepen introduced to us. These games reinforced our recognition of colors and ability to identify patterns.

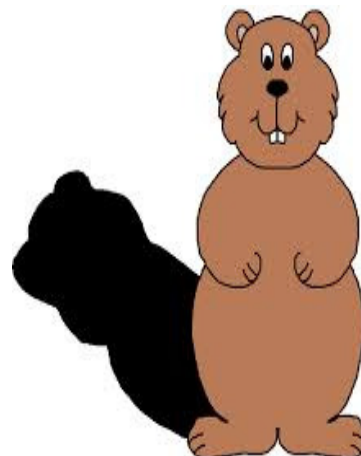
