## Chadron State Men's Basketball

### Brent Borgen - Head Men's Basketball Coach

Brent Borgen completed his seventh season at the reigns of the Chadron State men's basketball program in 2012-13. The Eagles improved their win total in each of Borgen's first four seasons guiding the team. In 2011-12, they won the second-most conference games in CSC history and finished tied for fourth in the 14-team RMAC. Borgen, a native of Millford, Nebraska, spent 11 years at Division I universities (Long Beach State and Kansas State). Growing up in a basketball family, and the son of a coach, Borgen has been associated with summer camps his entire life.
