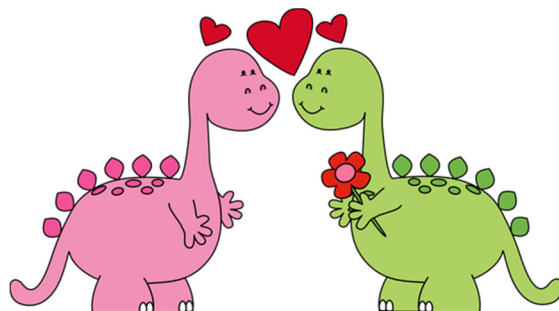
Look at what we are up to...
